

WASTE TYPE	MAY INCLUDE	NOTE
Metal and scrap metal	All metals, scrap metal, cast-iron pipe including lead caulking	Not insulated parts or electrical waste
Wood	All wooden material, nails and small fittings accepted	Not impregnated wood, logs, brushwood
Combustible	Wood, paper, corrugated cardboard, styrofoam, plastic packaging, cover paper	Not PVC, plaster, impregnated wood
Plaster	Plaster waste from new production and demolition, free of mortar, tile remains and ties	Dry, free of "rubbish"
Mineral material	Concrete, mortar and finishing mortar, brick, light concrete, sand etc.	Free of "rubbish"
Mixed waste	Unsorted waste	Not electrical waste, hazardous waste, PVC, tyres
Landfill	Mineral wool, demolition plaster, non-recyclable material	Must be described!
Electrical waste	Light sources, light fittings, power tools, white goods, refrigerators, freezers etc.	See hazardous waste
Hazardous waste	Asbestos, batteries, aerosols, paint, varnish, glue, sealing compounds etc.	See hazardous waste

WASTE TYPE	INCLUDES / MAY INCLUDE
Aerosols	Spray cans
Asbestos	Asbestos cement sheeting, pipe insulation
Batteries	Car batteries and small batteries sorted separately
Electrical waste	Everything with an electrical function
Light fittings	Do not dismantle fluorescent light fittings but remember to take the fluorescent tubes out
Paint	Paint and containers with paint residues
Impregnated wood	Decking, duckboards, sleepers, telegraph poles
Mercury	Thermometers, relays, switches etc.
Solvents	Petrol, white spirit, acetone, methanol etc.
PCBs	Sealing and jointing compound, condenser oil
